**Open Public Comment Period**. Individuals may address the Board on any topic within the scope of the Board's responsibility. To permit fair and orderly expression, commenters may be requested to sign in at the beginning of the meeting and individual input will be limited to five (5) minutes. The Board may control the time and manner of public comment and will not tolerate uncivil discourse or disruption. Individuals wishing to make a complaint concerning a district employee or program will be directed to do so in accordance with *Policy 4220-Complaints Concerning Staff or Programs* and related procedures. **Public Comment on Agenda Items**. The Board will provide opportunities for comments on agenda items that require or would benefit from public input. Individuals or groups desiring to comment should schedule such presentations in advance of the meeting.
